Oregon Lakes Association Conference Field Trip to Cascade Lakes Bend, Oregon area, October 26, 2019

change. There will also be very short hikes to sites near the lakes to see the geology and other natural history features. The buses will depart from the parking lot at the Riverhouse on the Deschutes, 3075 N Hwy 97, sharply at 1 pm on October 26 and will return at 5 pm that day.
