Oregon Lakes Association (OLA) is pleased to announce a \$1,500 graduate student award opportunity to support research related to Oregon's lakes, ponds, reservoirs, or their watersheds. Award funds can be used for equipment, supplies, travel, or other graduate student research expense.



Applications will be evaluated based on the quality of the proposed research, educational preparedness of the applicant, and significance to Oregon lakes, ponds, reservoirs, and their watersheds. Preference will be given to applicants with career goals related to the research and management of lentic waters and associated lotic waters. The successful applicant will present a poster or talk at an upcoming OLA Conference.

Application Requirements

Applicants must be enrolled in a college or university graduate program in the Pacific Northwest. To apply, please provide:

- Your biography including career goals (one-page limit)
- A statement of your research interests and their relevance to the field of limnology and/or watershed management (one-page limit)
- Your intended use of the award funds (one or two paragraphs)
- A resume or curriculum vitae
- Two letters of reference
